After School Club

We run an After-School Club at ACE from 4.00 to 5.30pm every school day. Parents can choose either the Short After School Club from 4.00 to 4.30pm or the Long After School Club from 4.00 to 5.30pm.

Places at the After School Club (“ASC”) are available to any child attending the Nursery School, subject to availability. All After-School Club children are provided with a healthy snack and a wide range of play activities.

Fees are charged on a termly basis and must be paid by the end of the first week that your child attends ACE after each holiday period. They may be paid termly or half-termly as preferred. Fees can be paid online to our bank account (Lloyds Sort code: 30-13-55 A/C no. 02629997 – please give your child’s name as a reference with any online payments). Alternatively, cheques should be made payable to ACE Nursery School (Cambridge) Ltd. and placed in the fees box in the parents’ room. To help us identify your payment, please write your child’s name on the reverse of the cheque (an envelope is not required). If you prefer to pay cash, please put it in an envelope clearly marked with your child’s name and the amount enclosed, and hand it to a member of staff. We also accept payment through childcare vouchers. Invoices will be issued to parents at the beginning of each term.

Fees for two year olds

Termly fees for two year olds are calculated by multiplying the number of hours attended per week by the hourly fee rate of £6.25 for the 38 weeks of the year we are open during term-time, all divided by three to give a termly total. For example, the fees for a two year old attending two long afterschool club sessions per week are calculated as follows: (3 hours per week x £6.25 per hour x 38 weeks)/3 = £237.50 per term. The following table sets out the approximate cost for two year olds for afterschool club sessions:

Extra sessions are sometimes available at short notice, at a higher rate than the normal fee. Extra sessions must be paid for on the day (or sooner). Whilst every effort will be made to accommodate those who ask for extra sessions, due to the constraints of numbers and staffing levels these cannot be guaranteed.

Fees for three and four year olds

The following fees are usually payable from the term following your child's third birthday. Universal Early Years Funding is available for most children from the term after their third birthday (specific dates apply – ask the office for further details). The first fifteen hours per week during term-time are free for eligible children at ACE Nursery School, and any hours in excess of fifteen are charged at £7.50 per hour for the 38 term-time weeks of the year we are open, all divided by three to give a termly cost. So for a three year old child attending ACE three days per week including long afterschool club (i.e. 8.45am – 5.30pm) this amounts to 26.25 hours per week. Fees would amount to $(11.25 \times £7.50 \times 38) / 3 = £1,068.75$ per term.

Extra sessions are sometimes available at short notice. Extra sessions must be paid for on the day (or sooner) and Early Years Funding cannot be used to pay for these sessions. Whilst every effort will be made to accommodate those who ask for extra sessions, due to the constraints of numbers and staffing levels these cannot be guaranteed.

WRITTEN NOTICE:

Each child is expected to attend ACE for at least one full term. Parents must give half a term's notice in writing before withdrawing their child from the school or reducing sessions. If this is not done they may be required to pay the fees for the following half term. The half a term's notice does not include holiday periods.
