

## **Outings Policy**

ACE believes children learn best through real life experiences and as such, we regularly take them out of the nursery to a variety of locations including:

- Central Library
- Sedgwick Museum
- Local shops and market stalls to buy ingredients for cooking activities
- Post office to send letters to friends who have helped at the Nursery
- Parkers Piece and the area around the nursery
- Local Catholic Church
- Local green spaces to play tennis or have yoga sessions
- Visiting ACE Day Nursery
- Annual school trip to Wandlebury Nature Reserve which parents are also invited to

The children learn to function as part of a group outside their usual environment and the bond between school, home and the child is reinforced.

In order to achieve successful outings we:

- Have a comprehensive health and safety checklist which the teachers use as they prepare for the outing
- Ensure the destination is appropriate to the age/stage/ability of those attending
- Some of the destinations we visit require the children to go up a number of flights of stairs; this is good for their physical development and should be the method chosen in normal circumstances. However, if a situation arises where a lift is required, this is permitted in the following instances:
  - 1. The lift is large enough for the whole group to fit in together
  - 2. If the lift isn't large enough, the group can be divided up ensuring there are at least two members of staff (or one staff member and one other adult; parent/volunteer) with each group of children. The groups must wait for each other and continue the journey together once the lift has been used.
  - 3. Please note that splitting up a group or using a lift is not ideal and will only be used as a last resort.
- The destination has been pre-visited by a member of staff to risk assess the journey and suitability for the group visiting
- If transport is required, it is with a reputable company and taxis fitted with seatbelts travelling by bus is permitted and teachers ensure children sit throughout the journey
- Parents/carers will be notified of the details and their permission sought before including a child on an outing
- Ratios: 1 adult (18 years plus) to 3 children maximum
- Should a child require 1:1 care this is will be organised
- A register will be taken for all those attending (children and adults) before setting off *and* before departing the venue

- Outings will be discussed and plans made with the teachers prior to setting off, and the outings checklist completed.
- Those who are part of an outing (adults and children) are marked in the registers
- A mobile phone will be taken in case of emergency
- First aid kits/inhalers/tissues/change of clothes/nappies etc will be taken as appropriate
- Children are supervised at all times
- All volunteer adults (parents/carers) who help with outings are told by the teachers what we need them to do and how to help us keep the group safe.
