

Toileting Policy



Before any forest school session begins, all children will be encouraged and given the opportunity to go to the toilet and children wearing nappies will be changed just before leaving.

At Logan's Meadow the children will be able to go on their own to the toilet, if they are able to. If the children require help they will be accompanied by a member of staff or their own parent.

- When children need the toilet or a nappy change, they will go with a member of staff a short distance away from where any of the other children are accessing the forest.
- We will find a small area to use as a 'pee tree' we will be mindful of the need to respect children's privacy and dignity.
- We will not over use the same space to reduce any effects it may have on the environment and follow the 'leave no trace' approach.
- We will ensure to follow ACE's procedures for toileting/and intimate care and ensure we use best hygiene practices.
- Parents are encouraged to provide children with waterproof trousers instead of 'all-in-ones' to aid the process of toileting.
- All waste will be bagged and disposed of appropriately off site.
- Children will wash their hands using hand soap and running water from the water butt.
- Toilet tissue and wipes will be supplied and disposed of appropriately.
