## For 1 year olds

All fees are charged on a calendar month basis and are payable on or before the first day of each calendar month. A returnable deposit is required when a place is accepted.

Fees are payable for the number of days your child is due to attend nursery over the school year, divided into 12 monthly payments. Invoices are issued at the start of the school year.

For children not in receipt of Early Years Funding (“EYF”) the following fees are applicable:

<b>Hourly Rate – for children <u>not eligible</u> for EYF</b>

For those children eligible for EYF, the following fees are applicable:

<b>Full day</b> (8.30am – 5.30pm) 9 hours long	Nothing to pay for funded hours for 38 weeks of the year and additional hours are charged at £11.00 per hour.	Nothing to pay for funded hours for 38 weeks of the year and additional hours are charged at £10.00 per hour. There is also a reduction on the total cost of additional hours equivalent to £1.00 per funded hour, representing the difference between ACE fees and the government’s funding rate.

For those children who are not in receipt of EYF, fees are reduced from the month after the one in which they turn two years of age. For children in receipt of EYF, fees are reduced from the term after the one in which they turn two years of age (to match the government’s funding periods). Please see our Fee Sheet for 2-3 year olds for further information about rates for older children.

EYF is available to eligible parents for 38 term-time weeks per year. Since ACE Day Nursery is open for more than 38 weeks of the year, we stretch funding claims across the period we are open. This means that funding equates to less than 30 hours per week.

## EXTRA SESSIONS

In an emergency it may be possible for your child to have an extra day (subject to availability) and this will be charged at £11.00 per hour (x 9 hours = £99 per day) if your child normally attends two or three days per

week, or £10.00 per hour (x 9 hours = £90 per day) if your child normally attends four days per week. EYF is not available to cover part or all of the cost of any extra days.

### **PAYMENT**

Please make payment online to our Lloyds bank account (ACE Nursery School/Cam/Ltd – ACE Day, sort code: 30-13-55, account number: 03026919). We also accept payments via the government's Tax-Free Childcare scheme. **All extras must be paid for on the day.**

### **WRITTEN NOTICE**

Each child is expected to attend ACE for at least two months. Parents must give seven weeks' notice in writing (which excludes our closure periods) before withdrawing their child from ACE Day Nursery (or reducing the number of days they attend). If this is not done, fees will be liable for the notice period and deducted from the deposit.
